






DAY 1:08 OCTOBER 2024

Welcome to Rome

DAY 2: 09 OCTOBER 2024

Explore Ancient Rome and the Vatican City

In the morning, enjoy the very best of the city's highlights, including visiting the magnificent St. Peter's Basilica in the Vatican. Then, gain priority entry to the Vatican Museums with a Local Specialist. Admire the Papal art collection and visit the breathtaking Sistine Chapel to marvel at Michelangelo's ceiling Masterpiece. Next, venture into Ancient Rome to see Circus Maximus, where the thundering noise of chariot races once filled the air. Then, view the mighty Colosseum (*entrance subject to availability) and the countless other ancient sites which featured prominently in the days of the powerful Roman Empire. The rest of the day is yours to explore at leisure. Sit on the Spanish Steps, shop up a storm on Via Veneto or continue your encounter with Ancient Rome on Palatine Hill to see the Temple of Apollo and Flavian Palace, among other excavations.

Admire Siena and Florence

You'll journey to Florence this afternoon where the Cradle of Renaissance comes alive in ways you could never imagine. You'll go back in time and learn how Florence drove innovation and imagination all those centuries ago.

DAY 4: 11 OCTOBER 2024

Explore Florence
