OUR PREACHER This Morning



Wess Stafford President Emeritus of Compassion International, one of the world's largest Christian child development organizations, partnering with more than 60 denominations and 7,000 local

churches to serve nearly 2 million children in 26 countries. He has worked both overseas and in leadership positions at ministry headquarters for four decades, and served as President and CEO of Compassion International for 20 years. The author of Too Small to Ignore: Why the Least of These Matters Most and Just a Minute: In the Heart of a Child, One Moment Can Last Forever, and host of the radio feature Speak Up with Compassion, Wess is an internationally recognized advocate for children in poverty, speaking up for those who cannot speak for themselves.

Wess' life experiences uniquely prepared him for this role. The son of missionaries to the Ivory Coast, Wess lived the proverb, "It takes a village to raise a child." He grew up as one of the village children, watched over by a wise and loving African "extended family." But his young heart was often broken when his African friends died too soon from the cruel ravages of poverty. Wess feels privileged to now minister to those who have always been so close to his heart.

Wess is a veteran, having served for four years in the U.S. Army as a linguist in military intelligence. An avid outdoorsman, Wess lives on a small ranch in Colorado with Donna, his wife of 37 years. They have two daughters, Jenny and Katie.
